- On-road / Traffic-free: Avon Cycleway (yellow line)
- Named / Signed routes (yellow dashed line)
- Traffic-free cycle routes (blue dashed line)
- Bridleway / Mountain biking (blue dashed line with diagonal ticks)
- Subway / Bridge / Tunnel (Indicates continuous route under road) (blue dashed line with vertical ticks)
- Linking routes (solid blue line)
- Bus / Cycle lane (solid blue line with white border)

- Cycle contra flow / One way (red and blue arrows)
- Footbridge (blue circle with diagonal line)
- A road (grey line)
- Motorway (grey line with M4)
- Railway / Station / Level crossing (red and blue symbols)
- Local authority boundary (dashed grey line)

- Public bike pump / BMX / Mountain biking (blue icons)

Symbols

- Tourist information / National Trust / Museum / Historic attraction (blue icons)
- Nature reserve / Heritage railway / Farm shop / Other attraction (blue icons)
