- Subway / Bridge / Tunnel (dotted blue lines)
- Linking routes (solid blue lines)
- Bus / Cycle lane (solid light blue lines)

- Cycle contra flow / One way (red and blue arrows symbol)
- Footbridge (blue circle with diagonal line symbol)
- A road (grey line)
- Motorway (M4 symbol)
- Railway / Station / Level crossing (red and blue symbols)
- Local authority boundary (dashed grey line)

Better By Bike

- Public bike pump / BMX / Mountain biking (symbols of a pump, BMX, and mountain bike)

Symbols

- Tourist information / National Trust / Museum / Historic attraction (various icons)
- Nature reserve / Heritage railway / Farm shop / Other attraction (various icons)
- University / College / School (Uni, Coll, Sch icons)
- Hospital / Park & Ride / Bus station (H, P-R, Bus icons)
- Sports or leisure centre / Library / Community centre (various icons)
